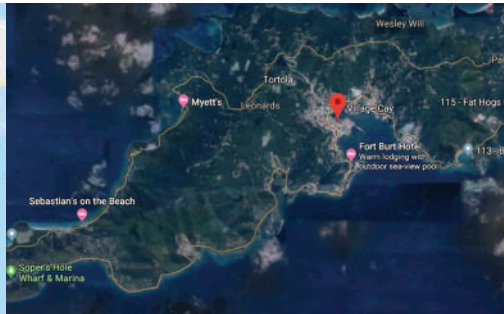
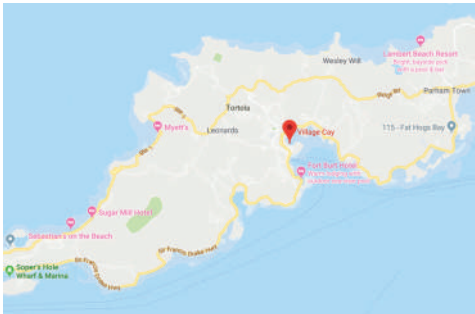

HOW TO GET HERE

Traveling from US fly to San Juan, Puerto Rico before connecting to Tortola (EIS) or fly to St. Thomas, USVI (STT) and take a ferry over from Charlotte Amalie.

TRANSFER

EIS airport - Village Cay Marina:
1 - 3 passengers \$28/way,
4 or more passengers: \$8 per person/way
From the ferry terminal to Village Cay Marina:
\$5 per person.
